

Poster Presentation Guidelines

1- Poster Size and format:

- The maximum poster size allowed is A0: 75 cm x 100 cm (27.56 inches x 39.37 inches)
- Poster should be in portrait orientation only
- Ensure high print quality (300 dpi)
- Material: Matte or fabric finish recommended (reduces glare)

2- Poster Content Requirements

- Your poster should clearly communicate your research in a visual and concise format:
- The content must be in English only.
- Title (large and readable from distance)
- Author(s) & affiliation(s)
- Introduction / Background
- Objectives
- Methodology
- Results (figures, graphs, images)
- Discussion
- Conclusion
- It is recommended that to have the name of the conference with logo on the top of the banner.

3- Font Size & Visibility

- Title: 80–100 pt
- Section headings: 40–60 pt
- Body text: 28–36 pt
- Must be readable from at least 1.5–2 meters away

4- Colours & Printing Considerations

- Use high contrast (dark text on light background)

- Avoid glossy finishes (causes reflection under lights)
- Ensure colors print correctly (test print recommended)
- Avoid very light text or overly bright backgrounds

5- Other Instructions

- All the poster presenters should bring their posters printed for the conference. There are no printing services available at the conference venue. It is preferred to have the poster printed in colour.
- The poster should be in a single page
- You are allotted a specific number for your poster in the program, and you are advised to stick your poster at allotted place.
